- More than 40,000 alumni

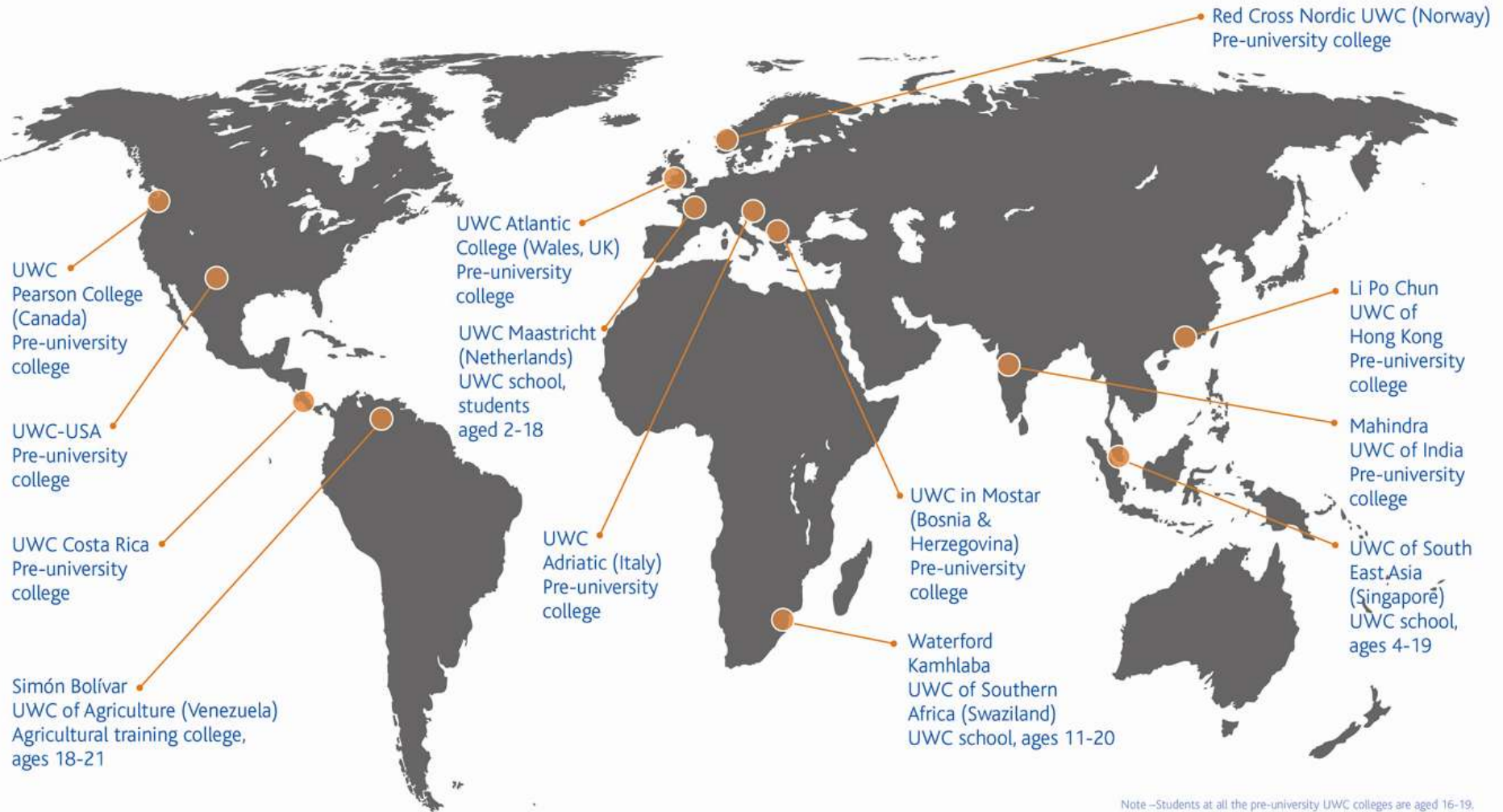
